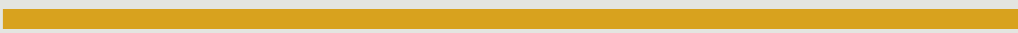
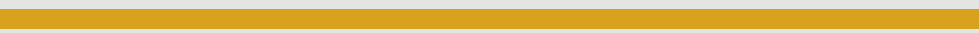
# ROUGH ITINERARY

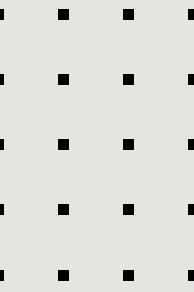

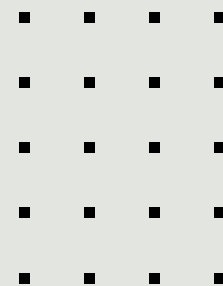
Depart from San Francisco International

- **Concert**

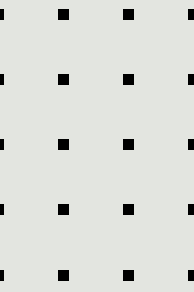

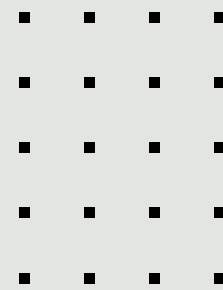

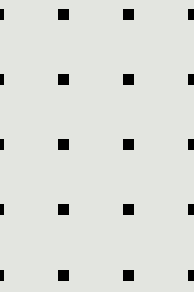




# DAY FOUR

- **Exchange concert with local HS**



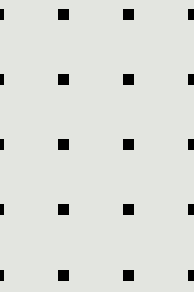

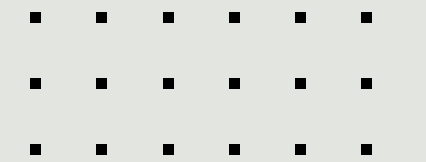
